

## **Independent Registered Municipal Advisor Disclosure Certificate**

Pursuant to Rule 15Ba1-1 (the “Municipal Advisor Rule”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), the Bridgeview Finance Corporation, Cook County, Illinois (“BFC”) has retained an independent registered municipal advisor.

The BFC is represented by and will rely on its municipal advisor Daniel Denys of Austin Meade Financial Ltd. to provide advice on proposals from financial services firms concerning the issuance of municipal securities (including investments of bond proceeds and escrow investments) as defined in the Municipal Advisor Rule (SEC Rule 15Ba1-1(d)(3)(vi)(B)) and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended). The individual with primary responsibility for advising the BFC is Mr. Daniel Denys, owner of Austin Meade Financial Ltd. This certificate may be relied upon until July 18, 2025, or so long as this letter remains posted on the BFC’s website or is otherwise withdrawn by the BFC.

The BFC intends that market participants receive and use it for purposes of Independent Registered Municipal Advisor exception to Rule 15B of the Securities and Exchange Act regarding Registration of Municipal Advisors (the SEC Municipal Advisor Rule).
